Staggered Closing

Q: What is staggered lot closing?

A: Staggered lot closing means that each lot closes individually at a pre-determined time, one minute apart. This style of auction is intended to hand you back your time by letting you know in advance when the lots you're interested in will close- so you're not a slave to your device for a whole afternoon, waiting for a sale to end.

Mobile Bidding

Q: I'll be away from my computer during a sale I want to bid in. Can I bid from my phone?

A: Absolutely, our platform is designed to be fully operational on a range of devices. To optimise your viewing, we suggest changing your view settings from 'List' to 'Grid' once you're on the sale screen. This will condense your lot view and allow you to see more lots on your page at once. This works well on your computer too!

Fast Bidding

Q: What is fast-bidding?

A: Fast Bidding is a feature designed to enhance your buying experience. It automatically closes lots once no further bidding activity is taking place, helping you focus on active lots and making the sale experience smoother and more efficient.

Closing Time

Q: What if I'm not available at the closing time of the lots I want to bid on?

A: No problem. Using the Max Bid function lets StockLive do the bidding for you- just enter the maximum price you want to pay for a lot when bidding opens and walk away.

Weighing

Q: Will all livestock be weighed?

A: Under the StockLive Terms & Conditions, all sheep and beef cattle offered for sale must be weighed by an assessor except for cows with calves at foot, ewes with lambs at foot, cows pregnancy tested in calf (PTIC) or scanned in lamb (SIL). Dairy cattle and stud animals may be listed weighed or unweighed, at the agent's discretion.
