Frequently Asked Questions

About StockLive

Q: Who is StockLive?

A: StockLive is an Australian-owned and operated online bidding platform that has been connecting buyers and sellers since 2017. Best known for its role in seedstock sales, StockLive now also offers a dedicated commercial livestock service. StockLive is independently owned by AAM and has no affiliation with any agency.

Independent Assessors

Q: Are StockLive Assessors employed by StockLive?

A: No. StockLive Approved Assessors are independent professionals, not employed or paid by StockLive. Each assessor undergoes a comprehensive screening and training program to ensure they uphold StockLive's high standards of data integrity throughout the assessment process. StockLive is 100% Australian-owned and independent of any livestock agency.

Recognised Prior Experience

Q: What is Recognised Prior Experience?

A: Recognised Prior Experience (RPE) refer to roles within the broader livestock supply chain that involve livestock classification. StockLive recognizes these as transferrable skill sets relevant to becoming an approved assessor. For a list of StockLive's RPE categories, simply complete the Assessor Form on our Commercial Sales homepage and the StockLive team will be in touch soon.

Assessment Process

Q: If I become a StockLive approved Assessor, how do I complete assessments?

A: Once you become an approved Assessor, you'll gain access to our online assessment tool which will allow you to enter your assessment information directly into the platform as you're doing your assessment - no more paper scribbles! It also includes a handy download you can use if you're offline or out of service, and upload back into the assessment once you're back in range.

Assessor Training

Q: What does the StockLive Assessor Training involve?

A: For Assessor nominees who satisfy our RPE and screening criteria, the training is an online course made up of 3 modules and an industry language handbook which standardizes the terminology and scoring frameworks used in our assessments. The training should take between 30-60 minutes to complete, is mobile-device friendly and can save your progress if you get called away.

Face to Face Training

Q: I want to become a StockLive approved Assessor but don't have any experience assessing livestock. How do I get started?

A: We're thrilled to hear you're interested in becoming a StockLive Approved Assessor! While current nominations are only open to those with experience in one of our Recognised Prior Experience (RPE) categories, we're excited to share that we're planning to introduce face-to-face assessor training opportunities in 2026.
